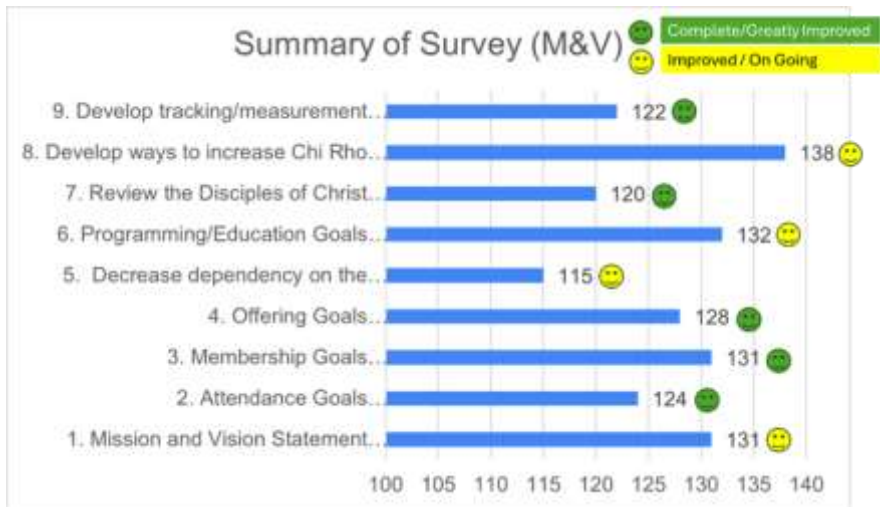

I strongly believe our actions that were demonstrated to our community and beyond please The Heart of God! Throughout 2024, with your support and prayers, we were able to provide more than 150 prison services reaching over 3000 incarcerated men and women.
